RE: 2018 Spring Clean-Up Programs and Vouchers

Dear Colleen Swedyk,

Albeit that it is cold and snowy now, spring will arrive before we know it! With the onset of warming weather, comes the urge for residents to embrace the season with cleaning and purging activities. The Solid Waste District would like to extend an opportunity to your community to bring bulk loose and bagged trash collected during a community-sponsored spring clean-up program, to the District's facility located at 8700 Lake Road, Seville, at a reduced gate rate.

Bulk trash includes such items as furniture; rolled and tied old carpet and carpet padding; home repair materials; large toys; and bagged clothes, fabrics, toys or other small household items. Items for which the District currently charges, or are prohibited from collecting, cannot be accepted as part of this the Spring Clean-Up Collection or Voucher Program. **A list of the District's "Charge" items is listed on the following page.**

A gate rate of \$30.00 per ton will be in effect from April 2, 2018 until July 28, 2018 for your community's specific clean-up program. The reduced gate rate for the disposal of bulk loose and bagged trash covers transport, disposal and part of the OEPA fee expenses incurred by the District. Please provide us the date(s) of your collection event; the solid waste hauler you will be utilizing; and the date(s) you anticipate these vehicles will be arriving at the District's facility for disposal. If your community is unable to sponsor a clean-up program in 2018, the District would like to offer your residents a disposal voucher. The disposal voucher can be utilized by a resident of your community to dispose of bulk loose or bagged trash materials at the District's facility for the discounted rate of \$30.00/ton. 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CHARGE ITEMS

ACCEPTED ONLY AT THE DISTRICT FACILITY:
8700 LAKE ROAD, SEVILLE.

THESE ITEMS ARE NOT ACCEPTED IN THE COUNTY-WIDE RECYCLING BINS

TIRES

Deposit only waste tires. Rims are not permitted.

- Tires up to and including 16.5" diameter (rim size) - \$1.50 per tire.
- Large tires (tractor/trailer) - \$6.25 per tire.
- Off road tires - \$26.50 per tire.

BAGS OF TRASH

Use the containers for bags of trash only. Single bags are \$1.25/bag (35 lbs. max).

TELEVISIONS AND MONITORS

- 19" or smaller - \$5.00 each
- 20" or larger - \$10.00 each
- Monitors - \$5.00 each

FLUORESCENT BULBS

- High intensity - \$1.25 each
- 4' Bulbs - \$0.35 each
- 8' Bulbs - \$0.55 each
