

Hinckley Township Board of Trustees – Special Meeting  
September 21, 2020

Chairman Ray Schulte called the Special Meeting of the Hinckley Township Board of Trustees to order on Monday, September 21, 2020 at 12:30 p.m. for the purpose to discuss and approve a resolution for the Board to adopt and send to the County Auditor for the collection of the delinquent waste disposal charges. Present were Trustees Augustine, Burns and Schulte, Fiscal Officer Catherwood, Chris Miller, Suzanne Peterlin, one reporter and one resident.

Mr. Schulte informed the Trustees that he has been working with Kimble to provide a list of outstanding accounts in order to comply with the contract requirement to send that list and a Resolution to the Medina County Auditor to have the outstanding Kimble balance assessed of the property owner’s property tax bill. He stated that Ms. Peterlin and Ms. Miller have been working diligently on preparing the list in the format requested by the Auditor’s Office.

Mr. Schulte stated that he was just informed that Kimble has sent the same outstanding debt list to a debt collection agency, it was agreed that this was duplicating the assessment process and will be problematic. A suggestion was made that Kimble may want to modify the contract if they would prefer to collect the outstanding debt themselves.

It was agreed that Mr. Schulte would contact Don Johnson from Kimble and Beth Biggins Ramer from the Medina County Solid Waste District to determine the next course of action.

The Trustees agreed to continue the Special Meeting after Mr. Schulte has more information as to how to proceed before sending the list and Resolution to the Auditor’s Office.

Mr. Schulte made a motion to close the Special Meeting at 1:05 p.m. Burns second. Vote: A-yes, B-yes, S-yes.
