

Hinckley Township Trustee Special Meeting
September 24, 2021

Trustee Burns called the Special Meeting of the Hinckley Township Board of Trustees to order at 3:30 p.m. on September 24, 2021. Present were Trustees Burns, Kalina and Augustine, Thomas Weiss of Lewis Land Professionals Inc. and one resident. Fiscal Officer Catherwood, attended virtually.

Chairman Burns stated the reason for the special meeting was to open bids received for the Bethany Lane Road Improvement Project and the possible awarding of the bid.

Mr. Weiss opened the sealed bids and announced the bid pricing as follows:

1. Wellington - \$314,360.00
2. Tri-Mor - \$349,970.00
3. DL Smith Concrete - \$363,533.00
4. Perk Company - \$360,217.00

Mr. Burns stated since all four bids exceeded the engineers estimate of \$262,185.00 by greater than 10% the Township had no other choice but to reject all bids and revisit the project in the spring of 2022.

There being no further discussion:

Mr. Burns made a motion to adopt Resolution #092421-01, rejecting all submitted bids for the Bethany Lane Road Improvement Project. Augustine second. Vote: K-yes, A-yes, B-yes.
