We hope this letter finds you well. In February 2022, we will begin the third year of our exclusive contract with Kimble Recycling and Disposal, Inc. for the collection and disposal of solid waste and recycling. As you know, this contract covers all Hinckley Township single and multiple family residents, enhancing residential solid waste collection and allowing for curbside recycling. **No action is needed if you are not changing your service level:** Residents will automatically continue at their current service level unless they choose to make a change.

## SERVICE LEVEL OPTIONS

### Full Service:

- 96-gallon solid waste cart (64-gallon cart available upon request)
- 64-gallon recycling cart (optional)
- Additional solid waste, yard waste and bulk items up to 2 cubic yards (an area no larger than 6 feet wide, 3 feet high and 3 feet depth)
- 2022 cost \$22.68 per month\*

### Bag Service:

- One or more Kimble specially marked 30-gallon bags (residents must purchase bags from Kimble, bags are sold in a packet of 10)
- 64-gallon recycling cart (optional)
- 2022 cost \$3.18 per bag + \$7.32 monthly routing fee\*

\* Prices may fluctuate slightly, up or down, based on changes in tipping fees charged by the disposal facility, fuel costs, and governmental fees that would affect any hauler. The contract limits such changes.

**Kimble Customer Service is also available to:** discuss recycling options, address questions on collection dates and times, solid waste vs. yard waste, bulk item pick-up, recycling, pricing, partial year residency and vacation holds. Residents should call Kimble directly if they need to report issues on trash day.

**Hinckley trash pick-up day is FRIDAY.**  
Please have your solid waste and/or recycling material at the curbside by 5:00 a.m.  
Messages from Kimble regarding service will appear on your bill or as an insert with your bill.

## REQUIREMENTS TO OPT-OUT OF TRASH SERVICE – YOU MUST RE-APPLY ANNUALLY

Residents who do not wish to receive residential waste services at their home may, in certain circumstances, be able to opt-out if one or more of the following requirements are met: **1)** you take your solid waste items to the Medina County Solid Waste District facility located at 8700 Lake Road, Seville Ohio 44273 and pay for disposal there, **2)** you take your solid waste to your own business (outside of Hinckley but within Medina County), or **3)** you have the permission of a business owner, who has a business within Medina County, to utilize the solid waste disposal service at that location.

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## HOW TO OPT-OUT OF TRASH SERVICE

- Residents must re-apply annually: Application affidavits must be reviewed and approved by the Township each year. Forms must be completed in entirety to be considered. Submit only one application per household.
- Complete the Application and Affidavit to Opt-Out of Solid Waste Services form included in this mailing. Forms are also available at the Township office or online at [www.hinckleytp.org](http://www.hinckleytp.org).
- Submit your application to Hinckley Township; **official submission will begin at 9:00 a.m. November 1, 2021 and end at 12:00 p.m. November 3, 2021**. Early submissions or submissions after November 3<sup>rd</sup> will not be accepted, this includes submissions before 9:00 a.m. on the 1<sup>st</sup> or after 12:00 p.m. on the 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Applications will be accepted **VIA EMAIL ONLY**; no postal service or in-person drop off will be accepted.

- Affidavits will be processed on a first come, first serve basis using Hinckley Township's Email receipt date and time.
- Please feel free to contact the Township should you have any questions regarding the completion of the form.

*In accordance with the contract with Kimble, opt-out numbers are limited to 5% of residences, and recalculated each year. The trash hauling contract cannot be changed to increase the opt-out percentage.*

## RESIDENTS MUST RE-APPLY FOR A VACANT, COMMERCIAL OR MEDICAL EXEMPTION ANNUALLY


Residents who have notified the Township of: **1)** a vacant property (not partial year residency), **2)** a property that shares a residence with a business that utilizes commercial trash hauling, **3)** a commercial trash hauling service for a Hinckley based business not located at their primary residence, or **4)** a request for medical assistance, must also re-apply.


Please contact the Township for the appropriate form. These applications are not under the first come, first serve mandate and may be submitted at any time, utilizing either postal or email submission. They are, however, under the same requirement of yearly submission, review and approval.
